

Log Violations Explained

01. **Logs Missing** – There must be a log sheet for each day, except that two or more consecutive off duty days may be on one sheet within the same month.
02. **Date Missing/Duplicate logs** – Each log sheet must be dated and there must be only one log for each day.
03. **Miles Driven Missing** – The driver who prepares the log must insert the actual miles he drove in that 24 hour period.
04. **Name of Carrier Missing / In Error** – Use the full company name and the full city name and state abbreviation.
05. **Vehicle Numbers Missing** – Show the unit numbers of all vehicles operated in the 24 hour period. The unit number must reflect the vehicle number on the unit or the license plate number and state of the unit.
06. **Driver's Signature Missing / In Error** – The driver must use his/her legal signature. The driver must also print name.
07. **Home terminal Address Missing / In Error**. – Location which driver reports to at start of shift.
08. **Hours Missing / In Error** – record the total hours at the end of each line of the graph. They must total 24 hours.
09. **Eleven Hour Violation** – A driver, after eight consecutive hours off duty, may not drive more than eleven hours in a 14 hour period.
10. **Over Maximum Average MPH** – Based on miles driven divided by hours driven.
11. **Changes In Duty Status Missing / In Error** – Use the full city name and state abbreviation for each duty status change.
12. **Stop / Start Location Not The Same** – the starting location on one log must be the same as the ending location on the previous log. Unless driver has been re-assigned to a different unit, location, or show.
13. **Fourteen Hour Violation** – A driver, after eight consecutive hours off, may not drive after being on duty for fourteen hours.
14. **From & To Missing / In Error** – Use the full city name and state abbreviation.
15. **Violation of 60/70 Hour Rule** – The maximum allowable working time of a driver is 70 hours in any eight consecutive day period.
16. **Log Falsification** – The times and locations on the log must agree with supporting documentation.
17. **Graph Incomplete / In Error** – All time on the graph must be completed. Overlapping time is not allowed.
18. **No Driving Time For Miles Driven** – There must be time on line 3, when driving miles are shown.
19. **DVIR Not Complete** -The driver vehicle condition report must be complete and signed daily.
20. **Abbreviated City Names** - Must enter the complete city name and state abbreviation for each duty status change.
21. **8 Hour Turn Around Violation** – The driver must have at least 8 consecutive hours off-duty between work shifts.
